#### **FUNDING**

2020 was a very busy year and we are proud of what we have accomplished. Thanks to supporters and partners 389 **animals received help they needed and deserved.** This is of what you helped make possible. Thank you!

### For the Love of Pets

This is AC ARF's signature program that serves low income Anderson County senior citizens with pets. With support from community, rescues, businesses, organizations and clinics, 324 animals that truly needed help were supported! Thank you! Below is what this program was able to accomplish.

Provided free pet food/supplies to 292 pets belonging to Anderson County seniors (valued at over \$23,500). Provided vet care for 15 dogs, 1 cat and 1 kitten. These pets underwent surgery to spay/neuter, repair torn ligaments, remove tumors, treat for illness and skin conditions, tested and vaccinated. Remember Shadow, Abby, Maggie, Gracie, Trixie, Jasmine, Sasha, DeDo and Rex. Spayed/neutered 16 community cats/kittens; 14 returned to caregivers and 2 placed as barn cats. In total 32 animals in this program received vet care.

# Adopt/Rehome/Rescue/Vet Care

We helped with rescue/vet care for Molly, Shadow, Champ, Grady, Penny, Colt and Kymber, Reba, Luna, Mac, 2 schnauzers, 2 min pins, 2 stray hounds, 2 blue heelers; 3 community kittens and a mama and her 4 kittens. We rescued, vetted and adopted April, an injured an injured Aussie, and helped adopt cats Roscoe/Raphael, Lonesome and Rosie cats. Working together with partners 37 animals were helped, and all are healthier and in homes! **Thank you all!** 

## Trap/Neuter/Return

Through our TNR Initiative with Shelter Animals Rescue Group an additional 40 community cats were spayed/neutered. 19 returned to their caregivers, 21 kittens rescued and rehomed. Paws up to our TNR partners and caretakers!

#### Outreach/Education

This year we offered 4 events to help the public better understand humane values. At the Museum of Appalachia folks learned about Pet Body Language. At Clinton Middle School students learned about community cats and their needs, and about healthy and safe nutrition for pets. Students participated by making outdoor cat shelters and healthy treats and toys to share.

AC ARF is a small but committed rescue. We will continue to grow and develop programs that help our community and its animals. We are already planning for our next Pet Expo, so stay tuned and join us in 2021!
